
Events and Activities

Training Programmes

The college has organised the following training programmes under various departments in March 2015.

Department of Computer Science and Engineering and Information Technology

A "Two Day Workshop on CISCO Networking" was organised as part of India's Biggest Networking Championship 2015 on 2nd and 3rd of March 2015 in which 106 students from CSE and ECE disciplines have



participated. The training was equivalent to CCNA certification course and was organised in association with ACM and IIT-Delhi. The workshop dealt with topics on network configuration, packet routing, IP configuration, and packet tracing. 
National Science Day Celebrations

Ugadi Celebrations on 20th March 2015



years old when I took my admission to Master's. It was a very different journey 11 years after I joined my Bachelors. Believe me, it is way more difficult to concentrate in classes and compete with students 10 years younger to me. It was fun to go through the process though, as I had made many friends across different age groups. I would do it all over again if I get a chance.

What was your first job?

After attending a few interviews for companies at C.DAC, Hyderabad, I could get a job as a Software Engineer at Satyam Computers (now Tech. Mahindra). However, I always wanted to pursue quality research at a very good institute in India or abroad. So I worked as a software Engineer for 3 years which I thought could fund my studies. Later, I took a break from my job and took up the position of a researcher at Dept. of Aerospace Engg. at IIT Kanpur for a stipend almost 1/5th of the salary that I had then been earning. I have to thank my Professor who had put faith in my passion, trusted me and supported me.

What is your current position?

Founder Director @ Rotavio Labs Private Limited. It is a start-up that I had founded along with Dr. Rohin Kumar and later we were joined by Mr. Vishnu Prasad, both of whom I had befriended at Helicopter Laboratory, IIT Kanpur

Tell us about your professional achievements.

Well, not many to talk about. But the company we founded is the only Start-up in India dedicated to Helicopters. We have been quite successful in getting a few projects but I believe we are yet to achieve something significant. Many a times, I feel 24 hours a day is not enough.

Tell us about your work experience.

I describe it as an eternal struggle to achieve something more and grander than what I had been previously working on. Electronics engineer to Flying officer (selected to Indian Airforce, but did not join as I realized I could not become a fighter pilot; its reserved only for National Defence Academy candidates) to Software Engineer to Aerospace Engineer to Entrepreneur / CEO. This has been my journey in the past 12 years after graduating from Aurora's !!

What qualities do you think the present engineering undergraduates require to succeed?

Passion, skill, tenacity and a goal. These are the virtues any person, including engineering graduates require to succeed. But most important of them all, one has to have the ability to overcome failures, learn lessons to create more opportunities for oneself and move on. Everybody who is successful would have gone through failures. But nobody can teach how to handle failures. One has to strive to change an unfavourable situation to a favourable one, not just succumb to one.

What do you miss the most at Aurora?

My friends. Well, there were many a times that I wished that I get a second chance to pursue engineering. There are quite a few things that I would have done differently. I certainly miss the campus spaces and the fresh air as Hyderabad has become a polluted concrete jungle with no tree cover at all.

Your message to the present students?

Successful is a person who not just knows what he can do, but also knows what he can't, better !! Give a try at a lot of things in life. Only if you try would you know if you are good at it or not. If you are good, well, you have another skill set to write about in your resume. Once you are above 24 / 25 years old, you don't get many chances to try out new things. Remember, good or bad, success or failure, you are always lucky :) . There is nothing called bad luck. Chart your own course and explore your own future.

How can our students reach you in case they need your help or advise?

I love to mentor students and help passionate individuals. But sadly, I am getting busier by the day with 18 hours a day already scheduled with activities. 




